Privacy Policy

AMCFSC is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the AMCFSC website and governs data collection and usage. By using the AMCFSC website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

AMCFSC collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. AMCFSC also collects anonymous demographic information such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by AMCFSC. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used by AMCFSC for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the AMCFSC website.

AMCFSC encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from AMCFSC so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. AMCFSC is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the AMCFSC family of websites.

Use of your Personal Information

AMCFSC collects and uses your personal information to operate the AMCFSC website and deliver the services you have requested. AMCFSC may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

AMCFSC does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. AMCFSC may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to AMCFSC, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

AMCFSC does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

AMCFSC keeps track of the websites and pages our customers visit within AMCFSC, in order to determine what AMCFSC services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within AMCFSC to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

AMCFSC websites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on AMCFSC or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of AMCFSC; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of AMCFSC or the public.

Use of Cookies

The AMCFSC website uses "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize AMCFSC pages, or register with AMCFSC site or services, a cookie helps AMCFSC to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same AMCFSC website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the AMCFSC features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the AMCFSC services or websites you visit.

Security of your Personal Information

AMCFSC secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. AMCFSC secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.

Changes to this Statement

AMCFSC will occasionally update this Statement of Privacy to reflect company and customer feedback. AMCFSC encourages you to periodically review this Statement to be informed of how AMCFSC is protecting your information.
